Increase processing speed. Executive function challenges, processing speed and behavior deficits often go hand-in-hand. Processing speed difficulties can limit productivity and executive function skills to complete routines; follow instructions; finish homework; listen/read and take notes/summarize; integrate and encode information; write assignments that require complex thoughts; transition between tasks; acquire new material; and reason under time demands. Slow PS can bog students down in the details and they can't distinguish relevant from minor details and see the big picture. Learn practical strategies to improve processing speed to increase the automatically with which students can follow routines and directions, complete tasks, and manage complex assignments.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?
