Key areas of shift will include:

- · From trauma-blind to trauma-informed
- · From compliance-driven to regulation-driven
- From sensory exposure/desensitization to sensory safety
- \cdot From cognitive therapy to interoception-based work
- · From deficit-focused to strength-based
- \cdot From theory of mind to theory of OWN mind
